Fanny Lemberger, née Bensinger Deported to Theresienstadt in 1942.

Fanny was born in Bodersweier near Kehl on November 3rd 1867. Her parents were Marie Braunschweig and Leopold Bensinger. She married Siegfried Lemberger, a cattle-dealer from Rexingen. The couple lived in Geissgasse, today 17 Osterhalde, and had five children. In 1933, their daughter Frieda emigrated to Haifa where she married Arthur Heimann from Rexingen. In 1941 Siegfried Lemberger died at the age of 78. That same year the eldest son, Isidor, was deported to Riga together with his wife and four sons. The daughters, Mina Kahn and Elsa Godlewsky, were also deported and murdered together with their husbands. The second son Karl Lemberger married Dorothea Wälder from 'Gasthaus Rose' in Rexingen. The couple fled to Palestine.

Fanny Lemberger was deported to Theresienstadt on September 23rd 1942 and then taken to Treblinka where she was murdered in the gas chamber.
