Willy Bodenheimer Deported to Riga in 1941.

Willy was born in Rexingen on July 18th 1887. He was the son of Emma Pressburger and Jakob Bodenheimer, brother-in-law of Bonna Bodenheimer. Together with his parents and his sister Flora he ran a soap-shop in 31 Kirchstrasse. Later he sold trousers as a peddler but in 1938 had to cease trading by order of the Nazi authorities.

His parents, Emma and Jakob Bodenheimer, died in 1932. Their daughter Flora died in 1939 at the age of 54. All three are buried in the cemetery in Rexingen.

In 1941 Willy Bodenheimer was deported to Riga. His brother Josef was deported from Frankfurt to the ghetto in Litzmannstadt and was later declared dead.
