Moritz Kalbkopf Deported to Theresienstadt in 1942.

Moritz was born in Czenstochau in Poland in 1862. He worked with marble. In 1906 he married the widow Mina Hochberger née Ottenheimer from Dettensee. The couple lived for some time in Mühringen as did Moritz Kalbkopf's parents, Matla and Syncha Kalbkopf.

Mina Kalbkopf died in Stuttgart in 1937 and is buried there.

Moritz Kalbkopf was deported from Stuttgart to Theresienstadt in 1942 where he died on February 15th 1943 as a result of uraemia related to prostate gland problems.
