Karolin Landauer, née Fröhlich Deported to Theresienstadt in 1942.

Karolin (Klärchen) was born in Rexingen on September 19th 1853. Her parents were Klara Rexinger and Abraham Fröhlich. She married Louis Landauer and the couple lived in 145 Brühlstrasse, today 27 Freudenstädter Strasse. They had three children: a daughter Emma born in 1886; another daughter Gertrud born in 1888, and a son Sali.

The children managed to emigrate. Louis Landauer died in 1921 at the age of 68 and is buried in Rexingen.

In February 1942, at the age of 88, Karolin Landauer went to a home for the aged to which Jews were forced to go in Eschenau near Heilbronn. From there she was deported to Theresienstadt on August 22nd 1942. She was almost 90 when she died in Theresienstadt in June 1943. Her death is documented in an obituary according to which her niece, Sophie Fröhlich, was also in Theresienstadt at that time.
