Elias Levi Deported to Riga in 1941.

Elias was born in Rexingen on September 5th 1879. His parents were Isak Levi and Karoline Rödelsheimer from Nordstetten.

Elias was a cattle-dealer, unmarried, and lived in 19 Kirchstrasse. His brother Max who lived in 20 Freudenstädter Strasse had a small flour business. Max emigrated with his family to France in 1933 after a window in their house had been deliberately smashed at Passover. His brother Sigmund ran a café – Café Levi – in Flösserwasen in Horb. In 1942 Sigmund was deported first to Theresienstadt and then to Treblinka where he was murdered.

Elias Levi was deported to Riga in 1941 together with his brother Samuel and sister-in-law Jeanette.
