## Salomon and Rosa Levi, née Hess Deported to Theresienstadt in 1942.

Rosa Hess was born in Malsch near Wiesloch on December 19th 1881. Her parents were Karoline Eschelbacher and Wolf Hess. She married Salomon Levi, a cattle-dealer from Rexingen. Salomon was born on February 8th 1874 to Sophie Schweizer from Baisingen and Emanuel Levi. He had three brothers: Abraham, Simon and Louis. All three died in Rexingen. His only sister Laura was later deported to Theresienstadt.

Rosa and Salomon Levi had one son, Wilhelm, born in 1907. The couple ran a cattle-dealing business together with their son in 45 Stuttgarter Strasse, Freudenstadt. In November 1935, they returned to Rexingen. In 1938 Wilhelm fled to the USA.

Rosa and Salomon Levi were deported to Theresienstadt in 1942 and on September 26th of that same year were taken from Theresienstadt to Treblinka where they were murdered.
