Betti Löwengart, née Löwengart Deported to Riga in 1941.

Betti was born in Rexingen on August 3rd 1879. Her parents were Dorchen Neckarsulmer and Max Löwengart.

She married Rubin Löwengart, a trader in leather goods. The couple had three children: Marie Meta, born in 1904, Elise, born in 1910 and Kurt, born in 1917. The family lived in 215 Ihlinger Weg, today 22 Lichtenbergstrasse. Betti's husband died in 1934 at the age of 59. In 1938 she had to pay 9,000 Reichsmark as a "Jewish property levy". Her daughter Elise and son Kurt managed to flee to the USA.

Betti Löwengart was probably shot in the forest of Biekerniki near Riga on March 26th 1942.
