Juditha (Jette) Löwenstein, née Weil Deported to Riga in 1941.

Juditha was born in Randegg, Constance, on December 8th 1882. Her parents were Berta Ullmann and Wilhelm Weil from Randegg.

She married Julius Löwenstein, a trader from Rexingen. They lived in 102 Brühlstrasse in Rexingen, today 22 Freudenstädter Strasse. Their son Siegfried was born on April 23rd 1913. Julius Löwenstein was a fusilier in World War I and was wounded. He died in 1925 when Siegfried was twelve years old.

Siegfried later moved to Frankfurt. In 1944 he was deported from Holland to Ausschwitz where he was murdered.
