Pauline Pressburger, née Pressburger Deported to Theresienstadt in 1942.

Pauline was born in Rexingen on March 3rd 1875. Her parents were Ricke Pressburger and Isak Pressburger who lived in Schöller. She married the cattle-dealer Max Pressburger, son of Sofie Zürndorfer and Elias Wolf Pressburger. They had a large farm in Schöller, the only large Jewish farm in Rexingen.

Four of their seven children managed to emigrate. One son committed suicide when he lost

his job. There is no trace of the fate of the other two children.

Max Pressburger died in 1938 and is buried in Rexingen. Pauline's sister Frederike and her brother-in-law, Berthold Schweizer from Baisingen, were deported to Riga in 1941.

On September 29th 1942 Pauline Pressburger was taken from Theresienstadt to Treblinka where she was murdered.
