Isak and Selma Schwarz, née Gideon Deported to Theresienstadt in 1942.

Selma Gideon was born in Rexingen on January 13th 1877. Her parents were Johanna Blumenthal from Wankheim and Jakob Gideon the 'Kaiser' innkeeper in Rexingen. She married Isak Schwarz, born on February 16th 1872. He was the son of Judith Löwengart and Simon Schwarz.

Selma and Isak had two children: Siegfried, born in 1903, and Rosa, born in 1910. Both children emigrated to the USA. Isak and Selma were deported to Theresienstadt in 1942. Isak's brother, Rubin Schwarz who was married in Laupheim, was also deported to Theresienstadt. Rubin died there on February 20th 1943.

October 9th 1943 was quoted as the date of death of Selma and Isak.
