Martha Schwarz Deported to Riga in 1941.

Martha was born in Mühringen on October 7th 1897 to Hannchen Esslinger and Albert Schwarz. She was the younger sister of Emma Feigenheimer. She lived in 150 Unten Im Dorf, today Graf-Gerold-Strasse, which she had bought from her brotherin-law, Julius Feigenheimer. Together with her brother-in-law, Salomon Elsässer, she ran a shoe-and-textile business.

Those Jews who still lived in Mühringen were forced to leave their homes and were sent to the Feigenheimer house in Burggasse prior to being sent to Rexingen in 1942. Martha, who was unmarried, was deported to Riga with her widowed sister, Emma Feigenheimer, in 1941.
