

Simon and Friederike Weil, née Pressburger

Deported to Izbica in 1942.

Both were born in Rexingen. Simon Weil, born on April 29th 1875, was the son of Sofie Levi and Berthold Weil. Friederike, born on August 18th 1881, was the daughter of Regina and Max Pressburger.

Simon Weil ran a cattle-dealing business in 77 Ihlinger Strasse. In World War I he was a member of the reserve brigade and was awarded the Medal of Merit of Württemberg for active service.

The couple had one daughter, Cilly, born in 1909. She married Josef Interstein from Strasbourg who spent some time trading in old rubber and tyres in Rexingen in the house of his parents-in-law. Cilly and Josef Interstein fled to the USA in 1939.

Simon Weil was forced to close his cattle-dealing business at the beginning of 1939. Both he and Friederike were deported to Izbica in 1942. The date of death of both Simon and Friederike was later declared as November 30th 1942.
